George Gluck, Candidate for MD Congressional District 8 Election Day Schedule and Availability, with Solar-Powered Start to Election Day

Rockville, MD—George Gluck demonstrates his commitment to a sustainable, green economy and tackling climate change by starting his Election Day schedule with an early morning, final “run for a healthy, sustainable Congress” from his house, which is powered 100% by solar and wind energy. He will then vote in person, and talk with voters through the day across the District. Immediately after polls close, he will be monitoring the vote count at the Montgomery County Board of Elections, then go to a local celebration of the people’s choice.

George is the only District 8 candidate who has made global warming a major campaign theme. He is also the only candidate who has personally run the entire length of the new District to introduce himself to voters, from the Pennsylvania border to the District of Columbia border (see website). George’s campaign theme is “Clean, Lean, Green” -- Clean: accepts no PAC money and no donations over \$100; Lean: minimal campaign budget, fiscal conservative; Green: champion of sustainable business.

2) Voting in Person (along with his eldest grandchild):

WHAT: Votes in Person at his Precinct ##?
WHEN: 8:45 am (arrive to vote); 9:30 am (estimated exit from voting)
WHERE: Flower Valley Elementary School, 4615 Sunflower Drive, Rockville, MD 20853

3) Visits to District 8 polling places throughout the day:

WHAT: Visit to three or more polling places
WHEN: Different polling place each hour on the half hour, 11:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.
WHERE: Text George’s cell number above for location at any time during the day

4) Exercising Right to Observe “Counting” of Votes at Montgomery County Board of Elections:

WHAT: Observing Vote Count to Demonstrate Difficulty of Citizens’ Right to Observe Counting
WHEN: 8:15 pm – 9 pm
WHERE: Starts and Finishes At His House: 4848 Sweetbirch Dr., Rockville, MD

5) Green Election Night Celebration:

WHAT: Green Party and Sustainability Supporters’ Party – celebration with sustainable party
WHEN: 9:30 p.m. – 11 p.m.
WHERE: Takoma Park or Rockville
